<p>This is a high honor program with ALL basic expense in China are fully covered. It is hosted by The China Overseas Exchange Association, and the organizer is the Foundation for US-China Cultural and Educational Exchanges. The Inviter will also provide basic travel safety insurance by China standards. It is the top priority for the host to ensure the safety thru the entire program, and in case something uncontrol-able happened, the host will take best care available on site, but assumes no further responsibility, neither legally, nor fiancially. Also to ensure the safety, members must follow all proper instructions from group leaders during the program.</p> <p>This program is in the summer time. In the places involved, the temperature could go as high as 40 deg C. And due to frequent travel, it is not easy to get good wash/dry equipment. You must prepare accordingly. The trip is mostly in Casual, but all needs prepare for 1-2 more formal sets (i.e shirts & ties for men).</p> <p>The electric standard in China is 220V; the currency exchange rate currently is about 1:8.07 (cash to cash) You must also get approval from, otherwise at least make aware to, your parent(s) about this program.</p>

Needed documents: valid passport, one 2x2 recent photo, Visa App form (Q1), an envelop with return address (no stamps) and \$45 to cover all visa fee, shipping back and handling.
