

Advanced Standing: AP High School course and AP Exam

A score of 5 on the appropriate AP Exam leads to credit for the following introductory physics courses at Penn.

<u>Exam</u>	<u>Score</u>	<u>Credit Awarded</u>	
AP "B"	5	PHYS 101 + 102	(3CU)
AP "1"*	5	PHYS 101	(1.5CU)
AP "2"*	5	PHYS 102	(1.5CU)
AP "C" Mechanics	5	PHYS 150	(1.5CU)
AP "C" Electromagnetism	5	PHYS 151	(1.5CU)

Please note that if you receive credit for an introductory Physics course at Penn, the AP Credit for that course or a similar one is lost.

***Note that as of Fall 2014, the algebra-based AP Physics course will change. Physics B will no longer be offered, and will be replaced by Physics 1 and Physics 2. Penn will award course credit for a score of 5 on the appropriate AP exam as listed above.**
