

Advanced Standing: Foreign Equivalent of an AP Course and AP Exam:

A sufficiently high score on the foreign equivalent of an AP Exam leads to credit for the following introductory physics courses at Penn.

You will receive credit for the appropriate course(s) automatically based on your Exam score, as detailed in the table below.

“A-levels”	A	PHYS 150 + 151
“A-levels”	B	PHYS 101 + 102
“A-levels”	C	No credit given.
Intl. Bacc. (SL)		No credit given.
Intl. Bacc. (HL)	6 or 7	PHYS 150 + 102
CEGEP	Superior	No credit given.
French Bacc.	>12, Coeff > 4	No credit given.
German Arbitur	>10	No credit given.

Note: No credit is awarded for “AS-level” courses. Other foreign exams may be eligible for credit – please consult with the Undergraduate Chair.

Please note that if you receive credit for an introductory Physics course at Penn, the AP Credit for that course or a similar one is lost.
